ACCESS PROCEDURES & CODES

As we aim to streamline the access procedures on the estate, please note that issuing a code to contractors or guests confirms a Resident has authorised their access.

Please make sure that your guests or contractors are made aware that valid identification in the form of a driver's license or ID document is an important requirement for entry.

In addition, issuing contractors with a code does not automatically grant them access. They must complete the access procedure at the security control room.

To prevent any delays and ensure that entry proceeds smoothly, we request that contractors complete their access application and submit it to us prior to their arrival.
